## WHAT TO EXPECT

In this 3-part training, NH school-level tiered teams will learn best practices for MTSS-B Schoolwide/Tier 1 and Advanced Tier (2/3) systems development with structured team planning time. The series will begin with a required orientation via Zoom followed by two in-person training days: Day 1 Schoolwide/Tier 1 strategies and Day 2 Advanced Tier (2/3) strategies. **Schools may choose to send teams to both in-person days or choose just one.** Either way, the online session is required.

## WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

School-level teams who are currently implementing or preparing to implement MTSS-B. Teams should bring **at least 2** (ideally 4-5) members, including MTSS-B leads, administrators, behavioral health providers, teachers, and/or partnering community mental health representatives.
